Who are the Aggie REPs?

The Aggie REPs are a group of AGEC and AGBU undergraduate students that concentrate on new student orientation, student mentoring, department/campus tours, and student-to-faculty communication. The Aggie REPs organization includes 10 - 25 undergraduate Agricultural Economics and Agribusiness students who are selected from among the applicants. The selection process involves both written applications and interviews. Aggie REPS are selected based on academic qualifications, leadership capabilities, personality characteristics, and commitment to service.

What are the Requirements?

Requirements of Aggie REPs students are that they be an AGBL, AGBU, or AGEC major, be a second-semester freshman, sophomore, junior, or first-semester senior, and have a minimum cumulative GPR of 2.50. While serving as an Aggie REP, individual semester GPRs must be at or above 2.50 for a course load of 12 or greater hours.

The application, and letter of recommendation must reach the NPFDA office **no later than May 31, 2017. Transcripts MUST arrive by June 10th.** Materials may arrive separately. Selection and notification will be completed by July 15th.

Applications received after the May 31, 2017 deadline will not be considered.

Selection criteria for the scholarship will include, but not be limited to the following:

1. Students must be in their **Junior** or **Senior** (college) year when they *receive* the scholarship - therefore may be a sophomore or Junior when applying.
2. Consideration of academic excellence.
3. Applicants must be enrolled as a *full time* student in a U.S. University/College.
4. Past and current involvement in poultry, agriculture and food business related activities.
5. Professional objectives of the student.

Scholarship checks will be forwarded to the Dean/Department Head/Financial aid (whichever is preferred by the winners school) during the summer and are to be disbursed to the student in equal installments each term after verification of the student's enrollment. Any unused funds are to be returned to The NPFDA Scholarship Foundation, Inc.

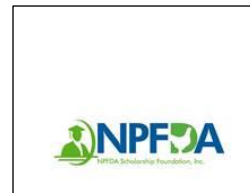
