ACCT 210 after ACCT 229

AGEC STUDENTS(only):

The prerequisite for ACCT 210 is ACCT 209. If you have completed ACCT 229 at another college and you are wishing to enroll in ACCT 210, please carefully read this email about how to enroll in ACCT 210.

If you have completed ACCT 229 and the class is on your transcript in HOWDY, please email Ms. Tyra Musoma at tmusoma@mays.tamu.edu. In the email, include your FIRST and LAST NAME; your UIN; and the term in which you want to enroll in ACCT 210: Summer 2017 or Fall 2017. She can place a prerequisite override on ACCT 210. She will not place a limit override on the class only a prerequisite override.

If you will be transferring ACCT 229 to TAMU and ACCT 229 is **not** currently on your transcript in HOWDY, please email Ms. Tyra Musoma at tmusoma@mays.tamu.edu. In the email, include your FIRST and LAST NAME; UIN; and the term in which you want to enroll in ACCT 210: Summer 2017 or Fall 2017. **In addition, you also need to forward a**

screen capture from the other institution's student portal (similar to our Howdy) that includes the institution's name, your name, the course and semester taken and grade earned.

Please contact Ms. Musoma with this information now if you will be needing a prerequisite override for ACCT 210.

Preregistration for Summer 2017 and Fall 2017 classes begins on Thursday, April 6, 2017.

To find your registration time, check in the My Record tab in HOWDY. In the top left box is the registration box,

the first item in the box is Registration Time Assignment, click on this link to find your time assignment.

Also in the My Record tab in HOWDY, **check for registration Holds**. This is found in the top center column of boxes in Grades and Transcripts. Click on Holds to see if you have any registration holds.

The Q-drop or withdraw deadline for Spring 2017 is Tuesday, April 18, 2107. You can get a copy of the q-drop form in our office or on-line at http://registrar.tamu.edu/Registrar/media/REGI_Forms/Q-Drop_Form.pdf. Completed and signed forms must be turned in to our office (AGLS 214) by Noon on Tuesday, April 18, 2017 for processing. If you q-drop a class, remember to watch your prerequisites. Only successfully completed courses fulfill a prerequisite.

Please see the attached file with important information about preregistration. **If you have questions or have a**

problem registering for a class, please see the attached as it contains the answers to most of your questions such as: prerequisites, submitting force request, and much more.

Also attached is information about the minors offered in our department and several other popular minors for our students.

If you are doing an **Internship** this summer and are interested in receiving academic credit, please meet with an advisor to determine if you meet the requirements for receiving internship credit, if you have any remaining degree requirements that internship credit can fulfill, and for details on how to proceed to receive internship credit. You **MUST** be enrolled in AGEC 484 prior to starting your internship to receive internship credit.
