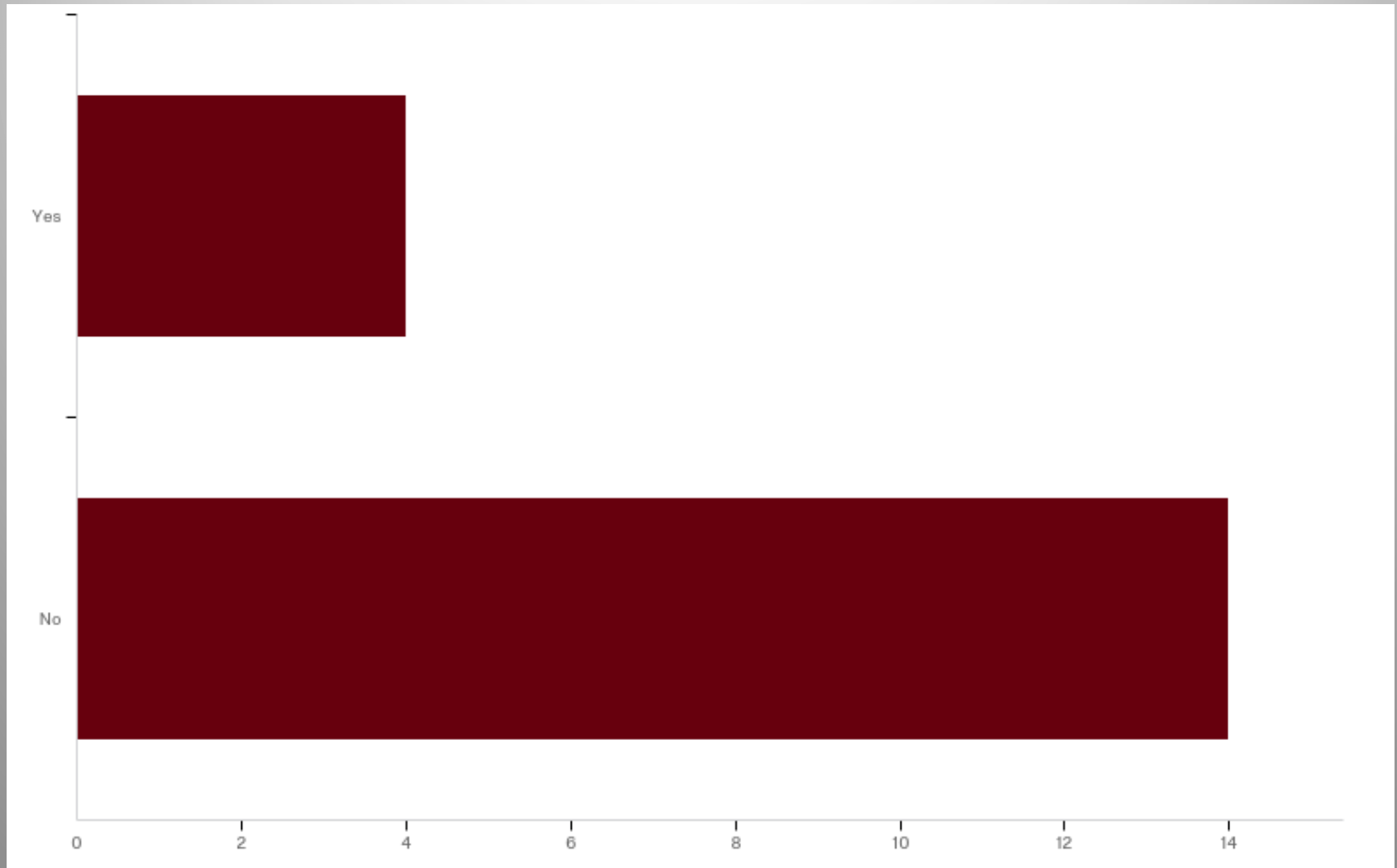

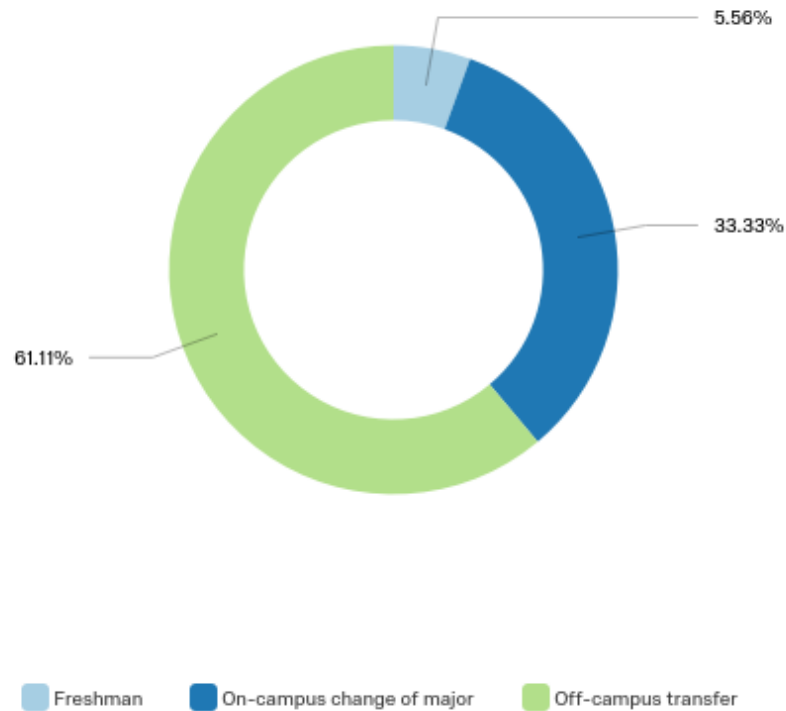

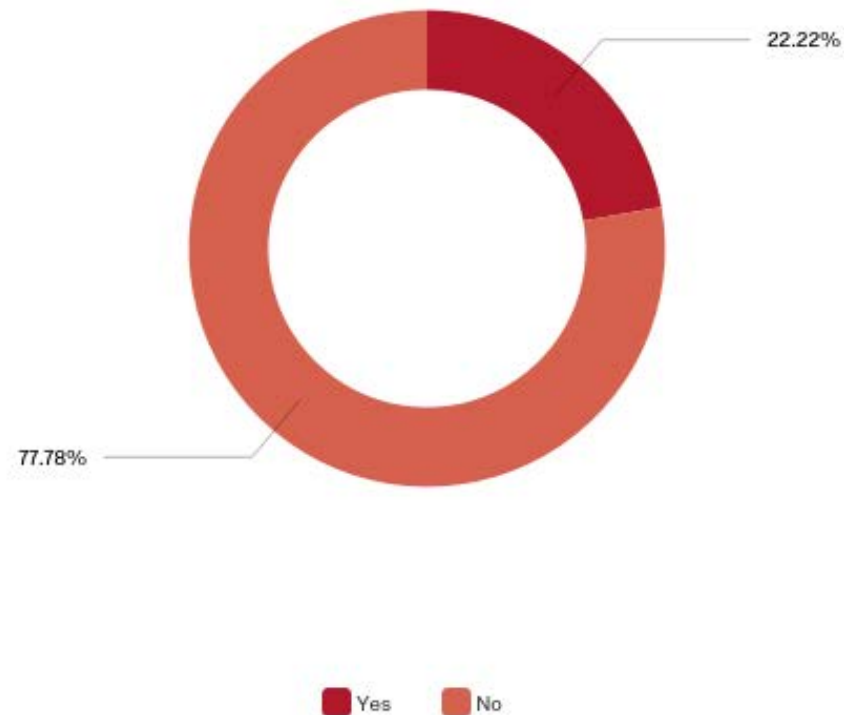

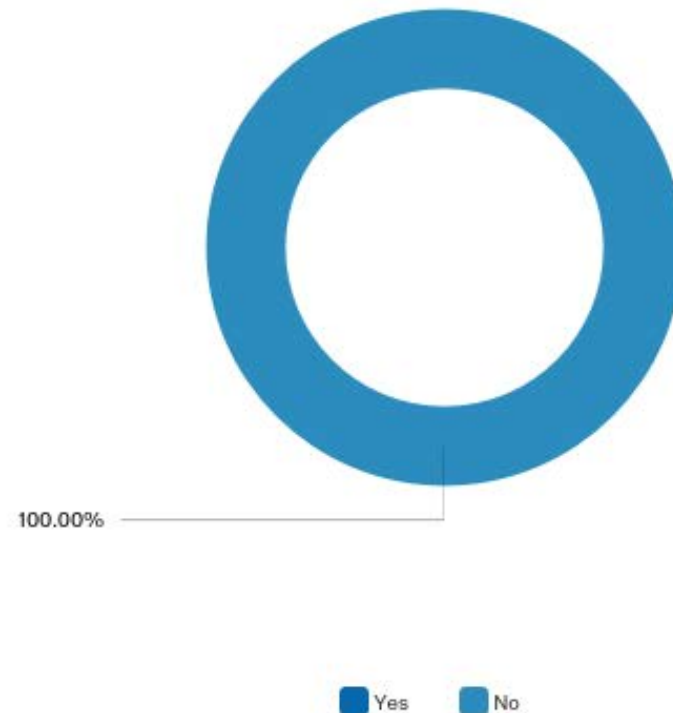
Which Departmental Clubs did you participate in?



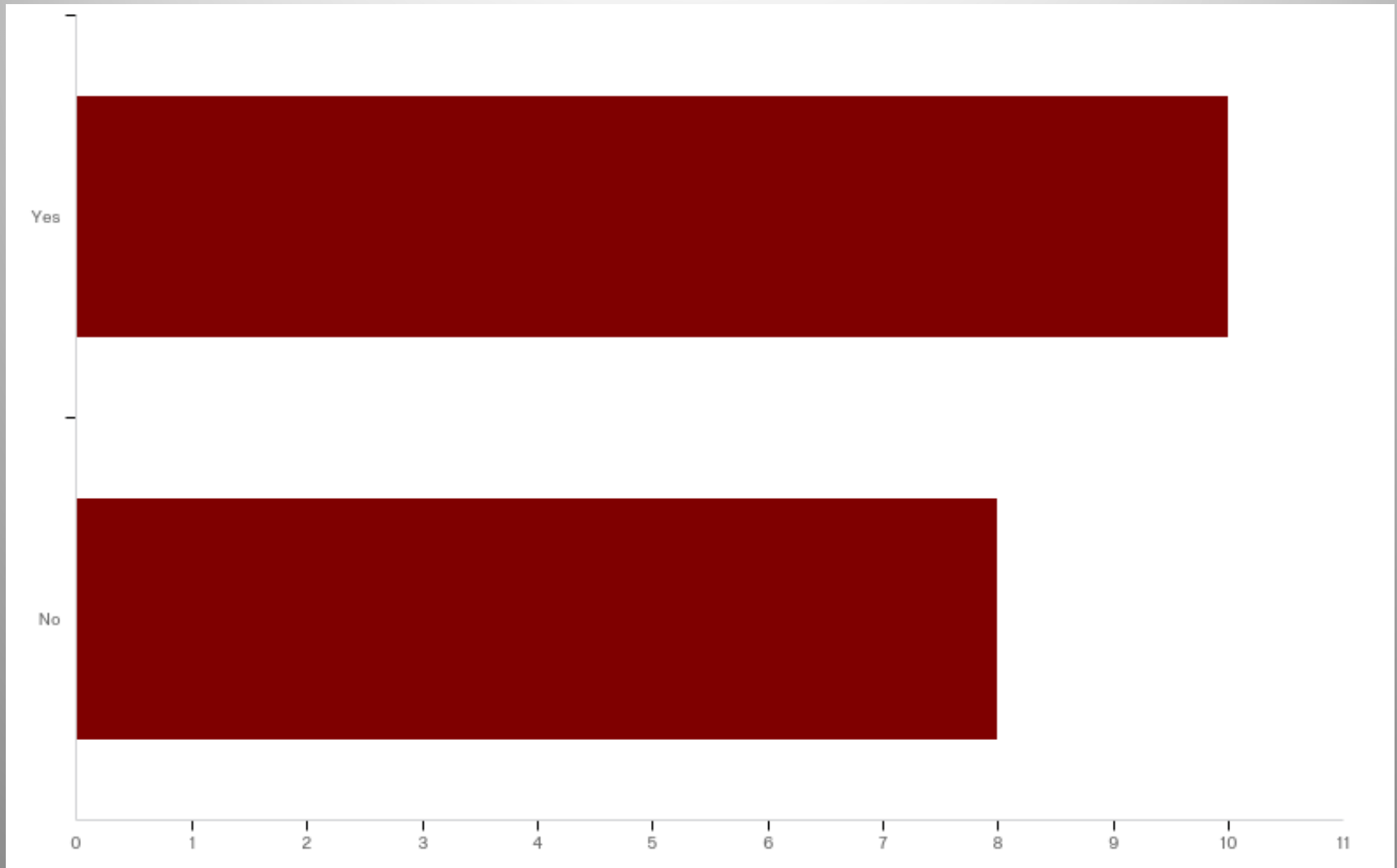

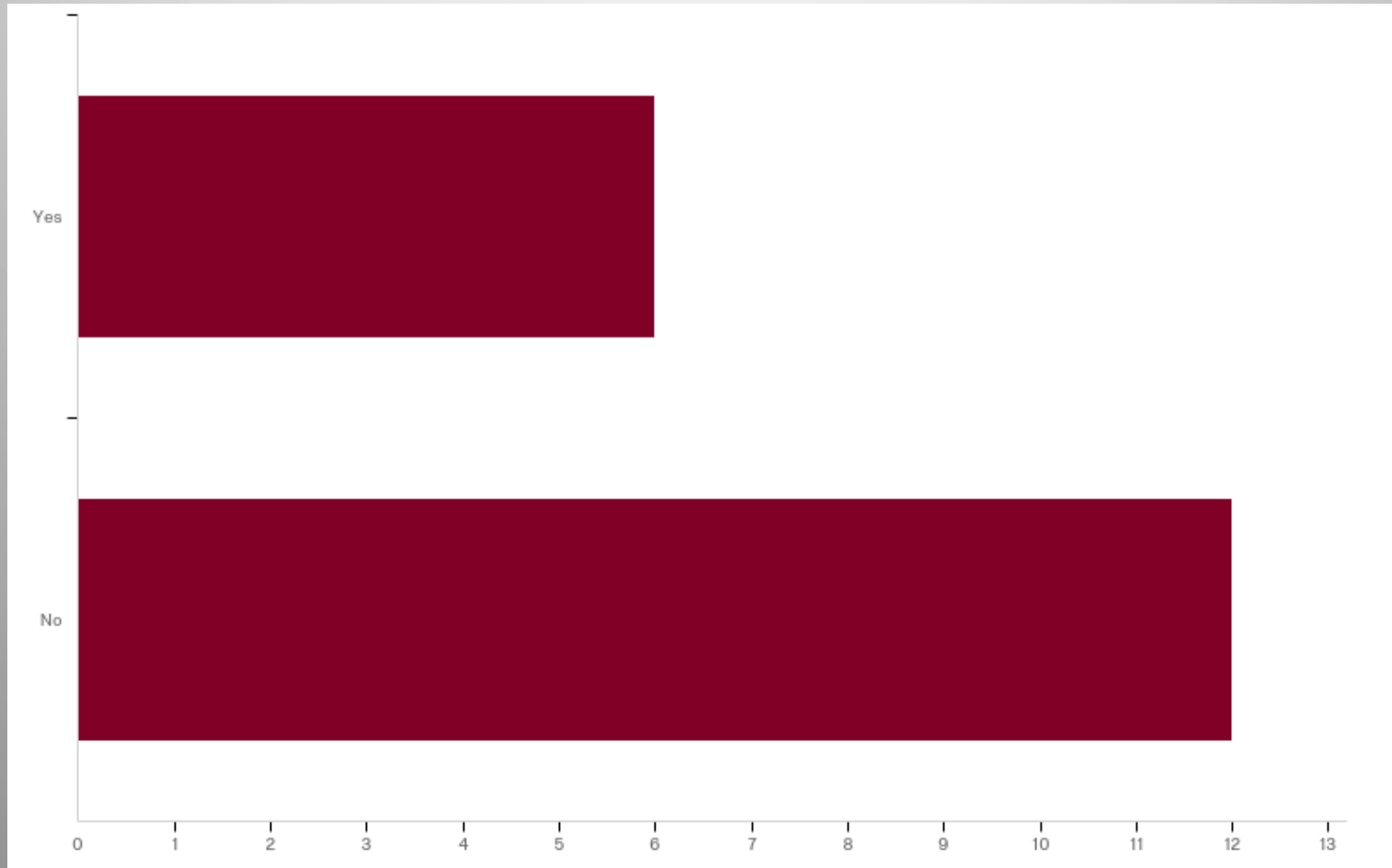
Did you hold an officer position or leadership role in any of the above clubs?

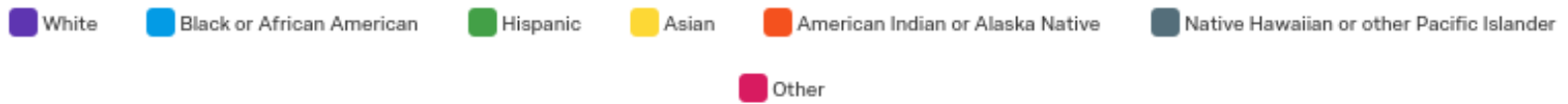
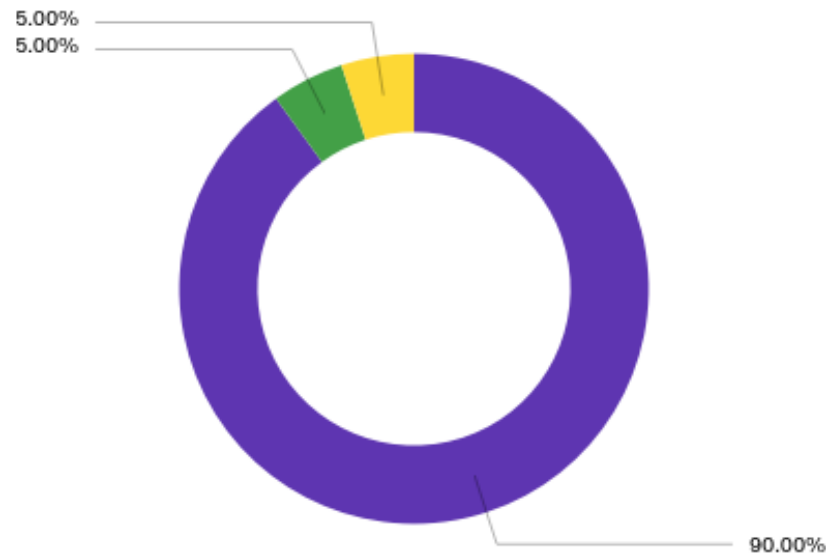
