COMPANY PROFILE:

AgTexas Farm Credit Services serves approximately 2,600 borrowers in a 43 county trade territory. The association has an average volume of approximately \$1.9 billion. The loan portfolio consists of cotton, peanuts, livestock, dairy, feed grains, real estate and ag-related business loans. The association territory provides diversity in production and mortgage loans as well as commodities financed. The Seminole office has \$46 million in direct loans to 110 members, consisting primarily of cotton, peanuts, sorghum and real estate.

MINIMUM EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE AND SKILL REQUIREMENTS:

Bachelor's degree in Business Administration, Finance, Agricultural Economics, or a related field, or equivalent experience. Three or more years of experience as a loan officer. Excellent oral and written communication skills as well as personal computer skills are required.
